Safe and Secure

When Grace International School was established in 1999, Boom Mosby was our first Thai language teacher. With only 169 students enrolled the first year, she was able to teach kindergarten through high school. She would often pray and worship with her students as well as spend time with their families outside of school. Having not grown up in a Christian home, Grace became her family and helped her grow in her faith. The sense of community she had found was something she had longed for and she was excited about her kids being a part of this community one day as well. Not surprisingly, she soon caught the eye of another Grace staff member. After dating for two years, they were married.

Boom turned her passion for children into establishing a groundbreaking nonprofit in Thailand. She is the founder and director of the Hug Project which advocates for child victims of human trafficking and sexual abuse. The Hug Project works with high level government officials, regional leaders, local police, and international law enforcement. Boom is the only NGO currently on the advisory committee for the Royal Thai police. The Hug Project also provides counselling services for the victims and at-risk children. As a ministry of The Family Connection Foundation, The Hug Project is the only nonprofit organization that advises the Royal Thai police in the area of human trafficking and child protection. In 2017, Boom Mosby received the “Hero’s Award” from the U.S. State Department for her victim centered approach in Thailand’s anti-trafficking efforts.

After meeting so many vulnerable children, Boom and her husband wanted to provide a safe environment for their own two children. The obvious answer for them, was to send their kids to Grace International School, which they saw as a school they could trust, a school that had values they agreed with, and a school where they knew their children would be safe. Boom said, “my husband and I travel a lot for our work and so we rely on Grace to provide a consistent environment where they can learn about God’s love. We are so thankful for the life transformation we have seen through our kids being a part of this environment.”

Because of the impact that Grace is having on their family, Boom has also encouraged the staff on her team to send their children to Grace as well. “The sense of security and peace of mind that Grace brings is amazing. I can’t think of a better place to send them!”
